On Saturday, December 5<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm. we will have Westphalia's *First Annual Village Light Parade and Christmas Tree Lighting*. The parade will go down Main Street.

Following the light parade with St. Nicholas, the tree lighting will occur outside the historical society building. Following the lighting, St. Nick will greet children and their families at the Ark, where hot chocolate will be served.
