"The second double wedding to occur at Holy Trinity church in Fowler within a week occurred Tuesday morning, April 29, when Clement Armbrustmacher, son of Herbert Armbrustmacher, well known Bengal township supervisor, took as his bride, Pauline Thelen, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Thelen of Westphalia township, and Clement's sister, Irene, became the bride of Pauline's brother, John. A case of brother and sister wedding brother and sister. Following the ceremony there was a reception at the Thelen, home 3 miles east of Westphalia, and a wedding dance at Spitzley's hall in the evening. The four principals are well known people and have many friends. Mr. and Mrs. Armbrustmacher will reside on the Armbrustmacher homestead in Bengal and Mr. and Mrs. Thelen on a farm 7 miles south of Fowler." *Clinton County Republican-News*, May 1, 1930, page 1, col. 8.
